Who Can Receive a Chromebook?

Household: individuals sharing income and expenses

A household (HH) is eligible if...

- Their total income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, and/or
- At least one member of the HH receives assistance from:
 - SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit or Lifeline
 - Tribal-specific programs, such as Tribal TANF
 - Free and reduced-price school meal program or a CEP school
 - o Federal Pell Grant
 - Broadband provider's existing low-income program



10,052 households in Carroll are eligible for SNAP benefits and **4,473 families** are at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Affordable Connectivity Program

Those who qualify for a Chromebook, will also qualify for the **Affordable Connectivity Program** (ACP).

Covers up to **\$30 per month**, or \$75 per month for those on qualifying Tribal lands, on a household's internet service plan. The household is responsible for any amount above that on their internet bill.

- Can be applied to any new or existing internet service plan from a participating provider.
- Is applied as a discount on the household's monthly service bill.
- Covers taxes and fees.

ACP Events
